The aim of this year's workshop is to allow the PhD-students to place their study in an international field, either by making international comparisons or transnational analyses, or by relating their specific study to the international line of research. Participating candidates should prepare to present their paper in approx 5-7 minutes, just enough to give everyone an overview of the topic. (We don't expect powerpoint-presentations!) All phd-students are responsible for reading one other paper, and for the supervisors 1-2 papers. At the workshop, the phd-students take the lead in commenting on the papers followed by complementary comments from one of the supervisors. Every paper is given a total of 30 minutes so please also spare a couple of minutes for the auditorium to eventually add some short comments. At the end of each day we will have time for some joint reflections.
